

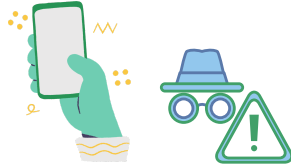

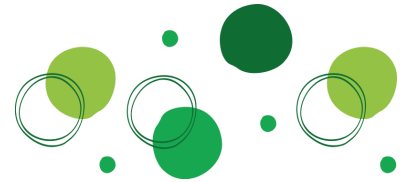
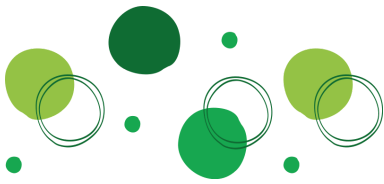


SOCIAL MEDIA INFORMATION FOR PARENTS AND CARERS
